Background Information on the West Texas Food Bank

The West Texas Food Bank seeks to eliminate hunger by procuring, storing and distributing surplus food and grocery products and transferring that product in usable quantities through a network of more than 180 community- and faith-based nonprofit organizations in 22 West Texas counties. Partnering agencies include food pantries, soup kitchens, after-school programs, senior citizen centers, low-income daycare centers, social service centers, emergency shelters, and residential treatment programs. The Food Bank, a nonprofit center for food distribution, is a member of America's Second Harvest, the nation's largest hunger-relief organization.

Job Function

Position performs routine duties related to sorting and repacking bulk food and grocery product for distribution, and other warehouse duties as needed.

Primary Duties and Responsibilities

- Presort, inspect, clean, sort and box product for distribution.
- Assist with record keeping associated with salvage and donated product inventory.
- Maintain and sanitize appropriate warehouse areas.
- Prepare and package agency orders for distribution.
- Follow first in, first out priority system of processing.
- Truck delivery when necessary.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

Qualification Requirements

Required:

- 18 years of age or older.
- High school diploma, G.E.D., or commensurate experience
- Able to lift heavy objects (50 pounds) and perform warehouse work
- Ability to stand for ½ a day
- Skill to operate pallet jacks.

- Able to work without close supervision.
- Willingness to work with and/or supervise volunteers.
- Work schedule flexibility
- Willingness to work overtime when necessary.
- Clean driving record and reliable transportation
- **Commitment to understanding and supporting WTFB's mission; Shows compassion and an appreciation for hunger issues.**

Desired:

- Bilingual: English/Spanish
- CDL Drivers License, or willingness to attain that license.
- Skill to operate forklift or willingness to learn.
